Diploma Pathways: 24-Credit vs. 18-Credit ACCEL

Palm Beach Prep offers two main high school graduation options in Florida: the 24-Credit Standard Diploma and the 18-Credit ACCEL (Academically Challenging Curriculum to Enhance Learning) Diploma. Here's how they compare:

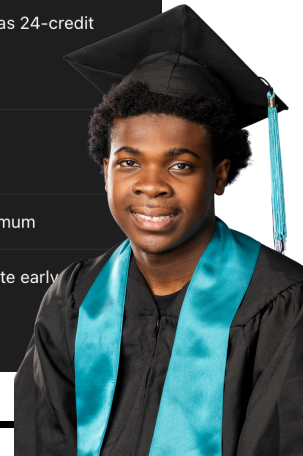
Category	24-Credit Standard Diploma	18-Credit ACCEL Diploma
Total Credits Required	24 Credits	18 Credits
Time to Graduation	Typically 4 years	Can be completed in 3 years or less
Physical Education	Required (1 credit with Health integration)	Not Required
Online Course Requirement	Required (at least one full course)	Not Required
Electives	8 credits of electives	3 credits of electives
Core Courses (Same in both)	4 English, 4 Math (incl. Algebra 1 & Geometry), 3 Science (incl. Biology), 3 Social Studies	Same core requirements as 24-credit plan
State Assessments	Must pass Algebra 1 EOC & 10th Grade FSA ELA	Same requirement
GPA Requirement	2.0 unweighted GPA minimum	2.0 unweighted GPA minimum
Best Fit For	Most students – offers flexibility, full high school experience	Students ready to graduate early on a career path

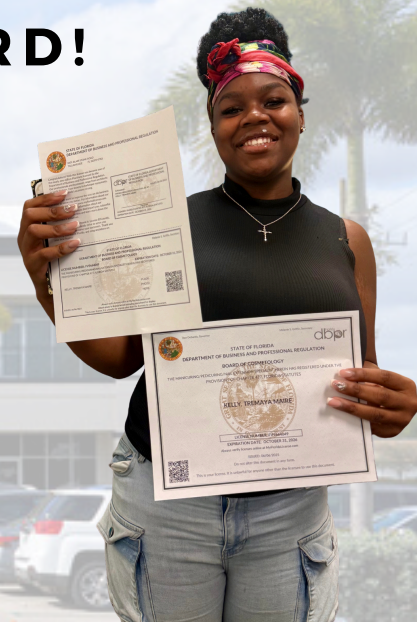
